



WCS Pearl Cays Hawksbill Conservation Project

Monthly Summary—September 2015

- Broke the all-time project record of nests in a season (475) on the 24th
- 100 nests recorded in September–2015 season total of 491
- 6 nests affected by poaching (1 Buttonwood, 2 Columbilla, 3 Wild Cane)
- 141 nests excavated—est. 22,002 baby turtles (hatchlings) have gone to sea so far in 2015
- Average of ~7.3 cays surveyed per day
- Total hours of survey in September was 139.33 (average per day: 4.64 hours)
- **4 turtles donated** to the project or rescued by WCS teams this month (3 adult female hawksbills, 1 adult loggerhead)
- Formal and informal education and outreach about sea turtle conservation and the hawksbill project done with 74 people visiting the Pearl Cays or WCS office in Pearl Lagoon (both national and international visitors, and 10 local fishermen).
